Every year as a school we participate in the event 'One Nation Reading Together' which is an initiative by a premier publishing organization to spread the joy of reading across our nation.

This year, 24th November, 12 noon to 12.30 pm was the designated time for this initiative across the country and indeed our school too.

At 12 noon, the 'Reading Pledge' was read out by each teacher in her class, both in Hindi and English.
